HATCHING EGG PRICE DETERMINATION ORDER #A-143

Order determining the standard mandatory price
to be paid for hatching eggs

The Ontario Broiler Hatching Egg & Chick Commission **HEREBY ORDERS AND DETERMINES AS FOLLOWS:**

INTERPRETATION

"hatching egg" means an egg intended to be hatched as a broiler chick.

APPLICATION:

1. a) Effective with all eggs set in incubators on or after 12:01 a.m., **Sunday February 12, 2017**, and until further order of this Commission, the standard mandatory price to be paid for hatching eggs in Ontario, by hatcheries licensed by the Commission, shall be **48.97 cents per saleable chick**.

b) Terms for payment shall be as per the Official Standard Contract and the pursuant schedules as set out in Regulation E-10, 1998.
2. Until further order of this Commission, the standard mandatory price to be paid for hatching eggs in Ontario by all persons other than licensed hatcheries shall be 35 cents per hatching egg.
3. No person or corporation shall buy, sell, or offer for sale, any hatching eggs at other than the standard mandatory price determined by this Order except as per Regulation D-1, Part III.
4. No other consideration shall pass between a buyer and a producer of hatching eggs except that as set out above.
